Teachers will register their entire team upon arrival of the facility. At this time teams will receive their t-shirts, lunch tickets, team information and receipts.

Teachers must bring team list that are present the day of the fishing tournament as well as the waiver form provided if they have not already been sent in!

Please encourage your students to wear sunglasses or glasses and bring the necessary gear for all weather types.

Lunch is provided but extra water and snacks should be brought by the students. However other beverages and snacks can be purchased at the site.

Any artificial bait can be used but worms are the only live bait. Additional worms will be available for sale during the tournament.

Keep in mind the target species are Bass, Trout and Pike. There are however many other types of fish in the waters.

There will be a mandatory meeting for all participants at 9:10AM! Here the rules of the tournament will be explained as well as the expectations of behavior and fair play. Seminars will be run continuously throughout the day for those interested.

At 1:30pm the tournament closing horn will sound and all students will be brought back to a final seminar and closing ceremonies including presentation awards.

Please stress to all students anyone violating any of the rules will be disqualified and asked to be removed from the property! Especially anyone entering the water or putting others in danger.

- take Hwy #3 West out of Aylmer (towards St. Thomas)
- turn left at Orwell (Springwater Rd)
- cross John Wise Line (Hwy 45) at the stop sign
- take first right on Pleasant Valley Line
- cross Catfish Creek and turn left at the sign Pleasant Valley Trout Farm

Directions from 401 ext. 195 (Westchester Bourne)

- once off the exit head south on Hwy 74(Belmont Road) towards Belmont
- go through Belmont until Hwy #3
- turn right onto Hwy#3 heading towards St. Thomas
- turn left onto Quaker Rd
- cross John Wise Line (Hwy 45)
- turn left onto Pleasant Valley Line
